DETERMINATION 18 of 2017 - DETERMINATION ON SALARY CLASSIFICATION FOR PERSONS APPOINTED BY THE TEACHING SERVICE COMMISSION AS TEACHERS IN THE SCHOOL SECTOR.

This Determination sets out the salary for persons employed by the Teaching Service Commission as Teachers in the School Sector. It comprises:

PART 1 - SALARY CLASSIFICATION FOR TEACHERS

PART 1 - GENERAL

- 1.1 Authority:
- 1.1.1 This Determination is issued in accordance with section 13(1) of the Government Remuneration Tribunal Act 1998 [CAP 250].
- 1.1.2 The Tribunal may issue guidance notes from time to time to assist the Teaching Service Commission in the administration of this Determination.
- 1.2 Application:
- 1.2.1 This Determination applies to persons employed by the Teaching Service Commission as Teachers in the School Sector.
- 1.2.2 This Determination may be applied to persons employed by the Teaching Service Commission as Lecturers, Tutors, Teachers, or Trainers in the Post-School Education and Training Sector.
- 1.2.3 No other person should be awarded the salary stated on this Determination other than those persons stated on sections 1.2.1 and 1.2.2 of this Determination.
- 1.3 Effective Date:
- 1.3.1 This Determination shall take effect on and from 1st January 2018.
- 1.3.2 As and when this Determination takes effect, it shall supersede and revoke any earlier determination or decision made on the salary of Teachers in the School sector.
- 1.3.3 As and when this Determination takes effect, it shall supersede and revoke any earlier determination or decision made on the allowance paid to persons holding positions of Principals or Deputy Principals.
- 1.3.4 PART 2 SALARY CLASSIFICATION FOR TEACHERS
- 2.1 A person with the requisite qualification and teaching experience specified on Table1A or Table 1B shall be paid the annual salary specified for the person on the Tables.
- 2.2 Each grade sets the maximum payable for the qualification level corresponding to the number of years of teaching experience.
- 2.3 No Teacher shall be paid more than 1 salary at any one time under any of the provisions of Table 1A and Table 1B and, if a Teacher holds 2 or more qualification, the salary payable to that Teacher is that payable for the highest qualification attained by that Teacher.
- 2.4 Adjustment to Salary: Subject to sections 2.1 and 2.2 of this Determination, adjustment to salary shall be made in accordance with established performance guidelines and within the ability of the Teaching Service Commission to retain the person with the necessary qualification and skills.

PART 3 - PRINCIPAL ALLOWANCE

- 3.1 Those Teachers appointed as Principals or Deputy Principals by the Teaching Service Commission should be paid a Principal allowance as set out on Table 2, if not already paid the salary of Principal or Deputy Principal.
- 3.2 The Allowance shall be applied to Lecturers, Tutors, Teachers and Trainers who are appointed as Curriculum Advisors, In-Service Trainers, Heads of Department, and Student Advisors.
- 3.3 Subject to Table 2, following is the guide for applying the allowance to officers stated on section 3.2 of this Determination and is based on the qualification level of the officers:

PART 4 - RELATED MATTERS

4.1 Take home pay entitlements: On and from 1st January 2018, those persons appointed as Principals, Deputy Principals, Lecturers, Tutors, Teachers and Trainers by the Teaching Service Commission will no longer be paid the following Take home pay entitlements: Child, Family or Spouse allowance, Cost of Living allowance, Entertainment allowance, Fuel allowance, Housing allowance, and Telephone allowance.


